- **3.** Primary Senior Leaders & Coach of Teaching & Learning will conduct multiple in-house PD training sessions to help teachers in their preparation to implement the new curriculum areas.
- 4. Primary Senior Leaders & Coach of Teaching & Learning will use PD resources from Alberta to assist teachers in their understanding of the new curricula and to assist them in ways of implementing them.
- 5. Subject area leaders in each grade level will meet to participate in unit planning sessions for the new curriculum areas (K-3 Math subject leaders, K-3 ELA subject leaders, K-6 PE & Wellness subject leaders).
- 6. Grade 3 to 6 Teachers will access & employ resources made available on the new LearnAlberta website that have been created by Alberta teachers specifically for these new curriculum areas.

> Kindergarten to Grade 3 Teachers will prepare a general, long-range plan for implementation of the new Alberta K-G3 ELA & Mathematics curricula for the following academic year (2022-2023).

> Kindergarten to Grade 6 Teachers will begin to implement the new Alberta K-G6 Physical Education and Wellbeing curriculum.

> Kindergarten to Grade 3 Teachers will implement the new Alberta K-G3 English Language Arts and Mathematics curricula.

August 2022:



September 2022-June 2023: Primary Senior Leaders & Coach of Teaching & Learning will regularly meet & work with subject area leaders in each grade level to assist them in unit planning sessions for the new curriculum areas (K-3 Math subject leaders, K-3 ELA subject leaders, K-6 PE & Wellness subject leaders).

February – April 2023:Primary Senior Leaders & Coach of Teaching & Learning begin planning<br/>for PD sessions with G4-6 Teachers for the preparation and<br/>implementation of the new Alberta G4-6 English Language Arts and<br/>Mathematics curricula.

May – June 2023:Primary Senior Leaders & Coach of Teaching & Learning create videos and<br/>PowerPoint presentations, then conduct PD sessions with Grade 4-6<br/>Teachers for the preparation and implementation of the new Alberta G4-<br/>6 English Language Arts and Mathematics curricula.
