Scholarships are awarded to students for the duration of their time at CAIS on the basis that they maintain each year their high level of achievement. Scholarships awarded range from 25% to 50% of the cost of annual tuition fees.

Step 2: Submit Application Form with Supporting Documentation

Completed application forms should be posted or submitted to **CAIS Admissions Office** with the following supporting documentation:

- 1. Copies of awards and certificates to substantiate the type of Scholarship requested.
- Documents to be submitted separately.
 TWO completed Referee Evaluation Forms for EACH Scholarship Type.
 (It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that referees are able to submit the evaluation forms directly to the School by post / email within two weeks upon the submission of the Scholarship Application Form)

Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Step 3: Attend Interview

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview.

Step 4: The School's Consideration

Students are expected to demonstrate a willingness and ability to support CAIS's mission, to apply themselves to academic study, and to participate fully in school life.
